Appellant Joseph C. Sun is appearing pro se without counsel in this case. He only has a copy of the Appellate Court rules as amended by Order dated January 29, 2009, effective April 29, 2009, by Order of the same date which rules are not current, but the latest rules are not yet published or available to the general public. All respondents in this case had filed motions for extension of time and were granted different dates to file their respondents' briefs. Respondents Matyusheky, CODA and Varg were granted extension of time until September 4, 2013, and



Respondent LiLing Sun was granted extension twice allowing her until October 4, 2013, to file their briefs respectively.

According to the Office of the Clerk, Appellant Sun was informed that the time required to file briefs had been changed and extended by order of the court but there was no publication of the new rules. Appellant is uncertain as to the exact time required by all parties to file their briefs and he has no information on the time required to file his reply brief. In this case, there were two (2) respondents' briefs to be filed on different dates, about a month apart. The two respondents' briefs may contain related matters and arguments which may need to be responded to by Appellant in the same reply brief.

Appellant therefore prays the court to extend the time for him to file his reply to the first respondents' brief until he has received the brief from the remaining respondent LiLing Sun, or in the alternative, grant him leave to file his reply brief and record of appeal to the first respondents' brief out of time. Because all the Respondents are filing their briefs on different dates in different months, Appellant further prays the court to set a time line for the filing of his Final Brief and Record on Appeal and/or any other matters.


