
Dear Ms. Kitchings:

Because U.S. Bank National Association (“U.S. Bank”) is unable to finalize the Record on Appeal until the Court rules on U.S. Bank’s Uncontested Motion to File Portions of the Record on Appeal Under Seal (the “Motion”), which is still pending a ruling by the Court, U.S. Bank respectfully requests a 20-day extension of its deadline to file the Record on Appeal (in both electronic and bound paper form) in the above-referenced matter. This is U.S. Bank’s first request for an extension of this deadline, and the requested extension will cause no prejudice to any party.

According to our calculations, U.S. Bank must file the Record on Appeal by August 4, 2025. If the requested extension is granted, the new filing deadline would be Monday, August 25, 2025. We also ask that the Court hold the current deadline in abeyance until an Order is issued on this request.


