

## ORDER

---

On June 11, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to strike portions of Appellant's designation of matter and the portions of Appellant's initial brief referencing the same. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion. Respondent filed a reply. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion to strike in part, and order the following stricken from Appellant's designation of matter: B(6) "Defendant's untimely production of critical discovery documents on November 12, 2024, previously requested by Appellant more than one year earlier." Respondent's request to require Appellant "to redact the names and confidential patient information contained in" Exhibit 24 and Exhibit 25 denied without prejudice because the request lacks sufficient specificity to address the confidential patient information and we deny the remainder of Respondent's motion to strike. Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended designation of matter that omits B(6).
