

ORDER

On June 23, 2025, this court dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to order the transcript as required by Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules and this court's letter dated June 4, 2025. On June 27, 2025, Appellant provided an invoice and receipt showing he purchased a transcript from Legal Eagle. On July 1, 2025, Appellant sent an email to this court asking if the receipt and invoice he provided would "get . . . the dismissal overturned." We construe these three documents as a motion to reinstate the appeal. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to reinstate the appeal. *See* Rule 260(a), SCACR ("A case shall not be reinstated except by leave of the court, upon good cause shown, after notice to all parties.").
