MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Terry S. Tyler with the Court of Appeals on June 26, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Ariel Robinson with the Court of Appeals on June 12, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Jeffery Wise with the Court of Appeals on June 11, 2025.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On July 29, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy


Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through August 30, 2025.
