Dear Clerk,

This letter serves as formal notice that the transcript for the virtual hearing held on June 18, 2025, before Judge Mattie Murphy in case number 2024-CP-1801459 has not been filed with the Court of Appeals. The transcript request form was submitted on June 28, 2025, and under South Carolina Appellate Court Rule 207(a)(2), the reporter is required to deliver the transcript within 30 days of the request.


As of today, August 6, 2025, that deadline has passed. We respectfully request that the Court of Appeals investigate the cause of this delay and, if appropriate, issue an order compelling the production of the June 18 transcript.

This transcript is material to the appellate review. Specifically, it is believed to contain statements made by Dorchester County and D.R. Horton, including factual errors regarding the status of Wise Lane and critical admissions by opposing counsel. It is our belief that this transcript is being improperly withheld or delayed to prevent appellate review of those statements and the actions taken at the hearing.


We ask that the Court treat this request as urgent and issue appropriate action to enforce Rule 207 and protect the integrity of the appellate record.

MOTION TO INVESTIGATE UNAUTHORIZED JURISDICTIONAL STATUS CHANGE AND TO  
COMPEL PRODUCTION OF TRANSCRIPT

MOTION TO INVESTIGATE UNAUTHORIZED JURISDICTIONAL STATUS CHANGE AND TO  
COMPEL PRODUCTION OF TRANSCRIPT

COMES NOW the Plaintiff-Appellant, Attia Elbadawy and Lynne Chatlos, respectfully moving this Honorable Court to initiate an internal investigation into an improper and unauthorized change in the jurisdictional status of lower court case number 2024-CP-1801459, and to compel immediate production of the official transcript of the hearing held on June 18, 2025 via Webex before the Honorable Judge Mattie Murphy.

In support of this motion, Plaintiff shows the following:

1. Plaintiff-Appellant has an active appeal currently pending before this Court regarding the underlying dispute in case 2024-CP-1801459.
2. On August 5, 2025, Plaintiff discovered that the public status of the above-captioned circuit court case had been changed from 'on appeal' to 'pending' in the Dorchester County Public Index.

3. This change occurred without the issuance of a remittitur from the Court of Appeals, in violation of Rule 221, SCACR.
4. No remittitur is shown on the Court of Appeals docket, and the appeal remains active and awaiting transcript delivery as of the date of this filing.
5. Plaintiff immediately notified the Court of Appeals Clerk's Office via email, and Emily Hyde confirmed receipt and stated the concern was documented and forwarded to the appropriate department.
6. Plaintiff has made diligent efforts to obtain the transcript of the June 18, 2025 Webex hearing, which was formally requested on June 28, 2025.
7. Despite repeated follow-up attempts, the transcript has not been produced.
8. Plaintiffs reasonably believes the delay is being influenced or obstructed by Bradley Mitchell, attorney for Dorchester County, due to the potentially damaging nature of statements made during that hearing on June 18th 2025.
9. Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court of Appeals investigate the status change and compel the lower court or relevant transcript office to produce the hearing record without further delay.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff-Appellant prays that this Honorable Court:

- a. Initiate an investigation into the unauthorized jurisdictional status change by the lower court.
- b. Compel the immediate production of the June 18, 2025 transcript of proceedings held via Webex before Judge Murphy.
- c. Issue an order restraining further action by the lower court absent a proper remittitur.
- d. Grant such further relief as the Court deems just and proper.


