Under the court order dated May 22, 2025, I respectfully submit the following status update regarding the above-referenced matter.

A hearing took place in the Charleston County Court of Common Pleas on July 29, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. in front of Judge McCoy. I was notified of the hearing via an email from Attorney Billingsley, which included details about the motion "MOFREE-Motion/Stay (per order filed 5/28/25)" for the case "2023CP1000305-John Nick vs. Emily Prioleau," added to the motions roster for the same date and time.

Following the hearing on July 29, 2025, I filed a Motion/Supplement Record with an Affidavit and Exhibits in the Charleston County Court of Common Pleas, and emailed a Notice of Filing in Trial Court Relevant to Appeal to the appellate court on August 5, 2025.
