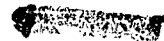



DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Burglary / Burglary (After June 20, 1985) - First degree

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On or about 1/12/2012, three defendants, identified as Zachary B. Bullock, Emmanuel L. Forrest, and De'Aisha L. Denton, did, without the owners consent, participate in a burglary of the victim's residence located at [redacted]. During the burglary Denton drove the car while Bullock and Forrest committed the actual burglary by forcing entry. Bullock and Forrest carried away a Glock .45 cal pistol, laptop, ipad, T.V.s and jewelry. Upon completion of the burglary Bullock and Forrest met up again with Denton who then drove them away from the scene. All defendants had prior knowledge in planning the burglary. A co-defendant has cooperated with the investigation and has provided information corroborating facts only the defendants would have known. Therefore, there is sufficient probable cause to believe the defendants committed burglary 1st degree.

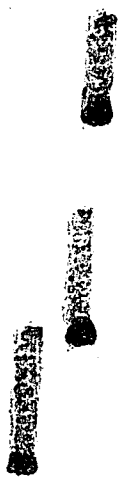




