Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I signed for and received your letter both dated and postmarked July 24, 2025, on July 30, 2025 at Kershaw C.I. mail room. Please allow for the ten (10) day period to correct deficiencies to begin on this date (July 30th 2025).

This Petitioner had no idea that the Letter sent on July 18, 2025, to the Court would be construed as a Motion To Recall Remittitur; otherwise, a Motion To Recall Remittitur and Proof of Service would have surely been sent to the Court in lieu

of a letter. However, the Petitioner is grateful to the Court for allowing the letter to suffice.

Your office will receive a fifty dollar (\$50.00) filing fee in a separate envelope. This Petitioner will be expecting a prompt and full refund of the filing fee once the Court gets this matter straightened out. Petitioner deposited the Motion To Reinstate Appeal and Proof of Service in the United States mail, postage prepaid on June 30, 2025, and was not processed by Kershaw C.I. mailroom until July 21, 2025 (three (3) weeks later!)

This is a prime example of Petitioner's claims regarding Kershaw C.I. mailroom need for help - especially towards any and all those with time sensitive legal correspondences. This Petitioner reiterates that the Kershaw C.I. mail room is not operating at a high level of efficiency and that the Petitioner in this matter should not be held liable for any disruptions and/or delays. A request has been made to the Court to address this issue; Petitioner doesn't know what else to do concerning the Kershaw C.I. mail room.

Also, it is beginning to appear (and maybe it's the Petitioner's frustration(s) with this process or the mind playing tricks) that the Petitioner is being deterred/discouraged by the Court concerning this matter on appeal for whatever reason. Petitioner respectfully submits to the Court that there isn't the slightest intention of abandoning this pursuit to achieve relief in this matter. Although the Petitioner readily admits to not being a highly skilled litigator (mistakes are undoubtedly going to occur), there exists a burning desire

to see this process through to the end. This Petitioner is not going away and would really appreciate the Court's continued assistance with the facilitation of this matter. Please pardon the Petitioner's candor; there is no disrespect intended, only true intention and desired expectation.

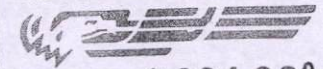

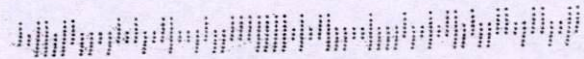
