ORDER


Intervenor John David has filed a motion to dismiss this appeal. The motion is denied. Within ten days of the date of this order, the parties shall agree on the record on appeal. Within thirty days after the agreement on the record on appeal, Appellant shall serve a copy of her final brief on every other party to the appeal and file her final brief with the Clerk of Court along with proof of service. Respondent and Intervenor David shall then have thirty days after the service of Appellant's brief to serve their briefs on all parties to the appeal and file a copy with the Clerk of Court along with proof of service. Appellant may file and serve a brief in reply within ten days after the service of Respondent's and Intervenor David's briefs.
