MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE

Counsel for Keldrekus Oglesby respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from August 15, 2025 until September 15, 2025**, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Devonte Anderson v. The State with this Court on July 18, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and the Appendix in the case of Bouvia Sales v. The State with this Court on July 18, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. James Curry with the Court of Appeals on July 7, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Reply Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. Rico Funderburk with the Court of Appeals on June 26, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Terry S. Tyler with the Court of Appeals on June 26, 2025.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On July 29, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously


