## ORDER

---

On July 28, 2025, Appellant moved to exceed the page limit for her amended initial brief, seeking to file an amended initial brief not exceeding eighty-five pages. On August 13, 2025, Appellant filed an amended motion to exceed the page limit. On August 15, 2025, Appellant conditionally filed an amended brief consisting of 105 pages. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's motion to exceed the page limit for her amended initial brief. *See* Rule 208(b)(5), SCACR (explaining "principal briefs shall not exceed fifty (50) pages" and allowing "the appellate court [to] grant a party permission to exceed those limitations"). Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief not exceeding fifty pages.

On June 16, 2025, Appellant filed a corrected designation of matter. On July 28, 2025, Appellant moved to file an amended designation of matter to add three items. On August 15, 2025, Appellant conditionally filed an amended designation of matter. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's motion to file an amended designation of matter and accept Appellant's August 15, 2025 conditionally-filed amended designation of matter as filed.
