Dear Ms. Howard:

This letter is the sixty-day status report pursuant to *In re Stays of Execution in Capital Cases*, 321 S.C. 544, 471 S.E.2d 140 (1996).

Mr. Stone's capital federal habeas corpus case, *Stone v. Stirling*, C/A No. 2:17-cv-01221-MGL-MGB, is stayed pending the resolution of this successive post-conviction relief case. Both Mr. Stone's retained expert and the Department of Disabilities and Special Needs designated examiner opined that Mr. Stone is a person with an Intellectual Disability and, therefore, ineligible for the death penalty pursuant to *Atkins v. Virginia*, 536 U.S. 304 (2002).

Judge Keesley convened an evidentiary hearing on July 30-31, 2024. At the conclusion of the hearing, Judge Keesley allowed parties to obtain a transcript of the hearing and submit post-hearing briefs. Mr. Stone submitted his post-hearing brief on February 4, 2025, the State responded on April 7, 2025, and Mr. Stone replied on May 2, 2025.
