MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Lorenzo Bernard Young respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days from August 20, 2025 until September 19, 2025 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Lorenzo Bernard Young respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



On August 12, 2025, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Michael Jeter with the Court of Appeals. On August 1, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Artrell Hickson v. The State with the Supreme Court. On July 28, 2025, counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in The State v. Lorenzo Boles with the Court of Appeals. On July 23, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Alexander Reid v. The State with the Supreme Court. On July 11, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Kashawn Shell v. The State with the Supreme Court. On June 27, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Joshua William Porch v. The State with the Supreme Court.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. On July 29, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through August 30, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension from August 20, 2025 until September 19, 2025 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.
