I am in receipt of correspondence from Mr. Guice regarding the above-referenced claim. He has appealed an Order of the Full Commission of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation claim dated July 19, 2013. The original date of accident of this claim is May 5, 2005. Therefore, pursuant to S.C. Code Ann §42-17-60 of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Act, the proper avenue for appeal from the Full Commission is to the Court of Common Pleas. This section was amended with the Reform Act in 2007; however, this claim clearly falls under the Pre-Reform Act. As such, Defendants respectfully assert that the Court of Appeals does not currently have jurisdiction over this claim.
