Response to Letter Dated August 20, 2025 - Appellate Case No. 2025-001313, Scott R. Manna v. Jack Sinclair

Dear Ms. Jenny Abbott Kitchings,

I am writing in response to your letter dated August 20, 2025, regarding the above-referenced appellate case, which I received today. As a pro se appellant, I was not aware of the requirement under Rule 207 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) to order the transcript within ten (10) days after the date of service of the notice of appeal. This oversight was unintentional and due to my lack of familiarity with appellate procedures, as I am representing myself without the benefit of legal counsel.

To address this matter promptly, I have today contacted the court reporter from the lower court (Court of Common Pleas) via email to request the preparation and furnishing of the full transcript of the proceedings. A copy of my email correspondence to the court reporter is attached for your reference [or pasted below, if preferred]. I have made satisfactory arrangements in writing for the transcript, including agreement on payment, and requested delivery as soon as possible in accordance with Rule 207.

Since the deadline for ordering the transcript has expired, I respectfully move the Court for permission to order the transcript outside of the filing deadlines set by Rule 207, SCACR. I believe this extension is warranted given my pro se status, the good faith nature of my appeal, and my immediate action upon receiving your letter to rectify the situation. Granting this motion will allow the appeal to proceed on its merits without prejudice to either party, and I assure the Court that I will comply with all future deadlines and requirements to the best of my ability.

Please advise if any additional forms, filings, or information are needed to support this motion. I kindly request that the appeal not be dismissed, as I am committed to pursuing it diligently.
