

That in Charleston County, South Carolina, between September 1, 2019 and October 27, 2020, the Defendant, Christopher Robert White, who was over fourteen (14) years of age, did willfully and lewdly commit or attempt to commit a lewd or lascivious act upon or with the body, or its parts, of Daniella Isabelle Shapleigh-Noy, a child under sixteen years of age, with the intent of arousing, appealing to, or gratifying the lust, passions, or sexual desires of the defendant or the child. That, in addition, if the defendant was 18 years of age or less and the child victim was at least 14 years of age, said lewd or lascivious conduct was non-consensual; in violation of Section 16-3-655(C), South Carolina Code of Laws, (1976), as amended.




The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:


That September 2019 through October 2020, while at 1033 Milcrest Dr. in the County and State aforesaid, the above named defendant, **Christopher Robert White**, did commit offense of violation section **16-3-655** of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976 as amended, **CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT with a MINOR 2nd DEGREE**, in that he did willfully, unlawfully and feloniously commit a sexual battery against the child victim (DOB: 05/03/2007), to wit: digitally penetrating the child victim's vagina.

That on October 29, 2020 during the child victim's forensic interview at Dee Norton Child Advocacy Center, the child victim disclosed that from September 2019 through October 2020 the defendant has been penetrating her vagina with his fingers. This has been occurring approximately every other weekend while the child victim would be visiting him at his residence. During the forensic interview the child victim was able to demonstrated the motions the defendant used with his hands during the assault.

This information is known through the investigation by Detective T. Miller along with the forensic interview of the child victim, and they are witnesses to prove the same against the form and dignity of the State.

DEFENDANT'S MOTION IN LIMINE
Opinion testimony of lay witnesses

Christopher Robert White moves this Court for an order directing the State to refrain from referring eliciting or alluding to or in any way bringing to the attention of the jury any opinion testimony from an outcry witness or other fact witness regarding causal or correlative links between the allegations of abuse and the child's behavior or other so-called "red flags." Such testimony would have the effect of impermissibly bolstering the child's testimony. *See, e.g. State v. Anderson*, 413 S.C. 212 (2015) and *State v. Kromah*, 401 S.C. 340 (2013). Such testimony would also impermissibly allow a percipient witness to offer testimony as to the ultimate issue, in violation of Rule 701.
