MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE  
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Nakia K. Johnson respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until September 22, 2025**, in which to serve and file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Nakia K. Johnson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Ontario Staley with the Court of Appeals on August 19, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Willie Ruth Byrd v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 18, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Maurio D. Rivers v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 18, 2025. Counsel filed the brief of respondent in the case of Joseph Todd Rowland v. The State with the Court of Appeals on June 25, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Donald Martin, III v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 19, 2025. Counsel filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of Willie M. Williams v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 17, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jeffrey Michael George with the Court of Appeals on May 30, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


