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PETITION FOR REHEARING

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SC Court of Appeals

Comes now, above captioned Appellant; Michael Rowland, pro-se respectfully moving this honorable court for a rehearing pursuant to Rule 221(a), SCACR.

In support of this request for rehearing Appellant believes this court may have inadvertently overlooked and/or miscalculated the time allotted by this court.

1) On June 27, 2025 this court issued a formal order letter allotting Appellant (10) ten days to file a motion to proceed out of time along with a fifty (\$50) dollar filing fee. Appellant timely complied both with the motion requesting permission to file out of time as well as paying the fifty dollar fee.

2) On August 11, 2025 Appellant received another letter order from this court dated August 4, 2025 stating "Appellant has failed to serve and file the record on appeal" and therefore the appeal is dismissed and the remittitur will issue.

3) Appellant believes the court may have overlooked this fact because the record on appeal was actually filed with the Notice of Appeal:

4) Since this is an appeal of the denial of parole and the ALC's order which was filed with the Notice of Appeal, Appellant is pro-se and was unaware that he had to resubmit the same ALC order of dismissal and the Parole Boards denial as a separate record on appeal:

5) If that be the case Appellant would suggest this was merely an oversight due to his lack of legal skill and knowledge and would ask the court to hold the remittitur, reinstate the appeal to the docket and allow hi an opportunity to resubmit the Parole Board's letter of rejection and the ALC's order of dismissal in the interest of justice.

### Conclusion

Based on the above and fundamental fairness Appellant would ask this court to grant rehearing and reinstate the appeal and allow Appellant to resubmit the two (2) documents that are the basis of the record on appeal in this matter since it was a routine denial of parole and a two page order of dismissal from ALC.
