ORDER

On June 5, 2025, Respondents Deutsche Bank National Trust Company as Trustee for agent John Kay; William Shepro and Altisource Solutions, Inc.; Hutchins Law Firm, LLP, a S.C. professional association; John S. Kay; and Alan Martin Stewart filed a motion to dismiss this appeal. On June 16, 2025, Appellants filed a return. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to dismiss because Appellants' amended initial brief does not comply with Rule 208 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

On June 20, 2025, Respondents Jeanette McBride; Joseph Strickland; Richland County Sheriff Leon Lott in his official capacity as the Sheriff of Richland County; and Sergeant Kyle Kovalchek filed a motion to dismiss the appeal from the order in circuit court case 2024-CP-40-05681.
