Dear Clerk of Court,

I respectfully write to follow up on my **Motion for Clarification under Rule 240**, filed on October 30, 2024, in Case No. 2024-001241. I paid the required \$50 fee at the time of filing, but no order has ever been issued on the motion.

This motion is critical because it asks the Court to clarify the scope of the automatic stay under Rule 241 and the Circuit Court's lack of jurisdiction to enforce the July 17, 2024 release order while the appeal is pending. Since the Circuit Court's contempt finding of September 16, 2024 arose directly from the release order, my liberty remains at risk unless the Court resolves this issue.

I respectfully insist that this Court rule on the pending motion. I greatly appreciate the Court's attention to ensuring that jurisdictional limits are respected and that constitutional protections are observed.
