## MOTION TO CURE DEFICIENCY AND ACCEPT FILING FEE NUNC PRO TUNC

NOW COMES the Appellant, Terry Clark, respectfully requesting that this Court allow Appellant to cure the deficiency noted in the August 29, 2025 Notice of Deficiency regarding the Motion for Damages, and states as follows:

1. On July 1, 2025, Appellant filed motions, including a Motion for Damages, Notice of Improper Trial, and related filings.
2. Since July 1, 2025, Appellant has received no acknowledgment, confirmation of transcript, or further communication from this Court regarding said filings.
3. On August 29, 2025, Appellant received a Notice of Deficiency stating that the Motion for Damages would not be considered due to lack of filing fee.
4. Appellant did not receive confirmation of payment instructions or acknowledgment that payment was required prior to this deficiency notice.
5. The absence of communication from this Court between July 1, 2025, and August 29, 2025, constitutes good cause for any delay in submission of the required fee.
6. Appellant stands ready and willing to promptly remit the filing fee upon acceptance by the Clerk of Court.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court:

- a. Accept the required filing fee nunc pro tunc ("now for then"), curing the deficiency retroactively;
- b. Reinstate and consider the Motion for Damages on its merits; and
- c. Grant such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.
