

ORDER

On July 24, 2025, the court granted a motion filed by Respondent Department of Social Services (DSS) to seal the second and third supplemental records on appeal. Respondent Tammy Gaye Causey Dalsing and Edward Anthony Dalsing filed a motion reflecting their intent to join in Respondent DSS's motion to seal the second and third supplemental records on appeal. After careful consideration, we decline to consider Respondents Dalsings' motion to join DSS's motion to seal as moot.

On July 23, 2025, Respondents Dalsings moved to supplement the record a second time, on the basis they discovered four designated pages were missing, and they sought an extension of time to file their final brief. The motion indicates Appellant agreed to supplement the record on appeal with these four pages. On July 31, 2025, Appellant filed a fourth supplemental record on appeal that contains the missing four documents. On August 7, 2025, Respondents Dalsings filed their final brief. After careful consideration, we grant the July 23, 2025 motion to supplement the record and accept the fourth supplemental record as filed.
