MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED WITHOUT ADDITIONAL FEES

NOW COMES Petitioner Carolyn Brantley, appearing pro se, and respectfully moves this Honorable Court for leave to proceed without the imposition of additional filing fees, and in support thereof states:

1. Petitioner has previously rendered payment of filing fees to this Court for services which, due to jurisdictional posture and the Court’s order, were not effectuated to final adjudication.
2. On August 21, 2025, this Court, through correspondence issued by its Clerk’s Office, advised Petitioner that she retains the right under Rule 242(c), SCACR to seek review by writ of certiorari following the Court of Appeals’ final decision.
3. To require duplicative or additional fees, under these unique circumstances, would impose an undue burden upon Petitioner and effectively deny her meaningful access to this Court in contravention of both the South Carolina Constitution, Art. I, § 9 (Open Courts Clause) and the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully prays that this Honorable Court grant leave to file the accompanying Writ of Certiorari without the requirement of further fees, recognizing her prior payment as sufficient, and allow this matter to proceed on its merits.
