Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed. This is the Court's third request for these corrections:


- A proof of service has not been provided for the complete record on appeal. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The argument provided cannot be considered as part of your record on appeal. The record on appeal must only include all matter designated to be included by both parties pursuant to Rule 210(c), SCACR.
- Your record on appeal must include an index that lists all documents within and the page numbers that they begin on pursuant to Rule 210(e), SCACR.
- Each page of the record on appeal must be numbered consecutively beginning with the index pursuant to Rule 210(c), SCACR.
- You must include the case caption on the cover of the record on appeal and it must match exactly with the one given below. Please refer to Form 15 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR as an example.
