Dear Caroline Horlbeck:

I, Elliot Brown, am writing in concern to a letter I received dated June 11, 2013, from the Supreme Court of South Carolina addressed to your office advising you as counsel to file an Rule 243(c) on my belated direct appeal. This order was for counsel to provide an written explanation as to why the PCR determination was improper and for counsel to advise I, Elliot Brown that I had an opportunity to provide pro se argument within twenty (20) days from the date of letter to file under *Dennison v. State*, 371 S.C. 221, 639 S.E. 2d 35 (2006). I do not have no such document advising me that I could file pro se because I would have filed an petition on my behalf.

As, you are aware the Court of Appeal, The Supreme Court of South Carolina, and Appellate Defense have no record of an appeal pending due to your negligence not filing the petition required by Rule 243.

However, due to Rule 71.1 (g) Continuing Representation as counsel for petitioner you were not relieved of your duty's as attorney representing my appeal under Rule 602 or allowed to withdraw under Rule 264 there are no record on file. So, I respectfully request clear clarification why counsel did not file an petition on my behalf or advise petitioner that I had an opportunity to do it on my own.

I, patiently await your response in this matter, with instruction on how to proceed at this point, of any prose petition allowed by the court to further my appeal proceedings.

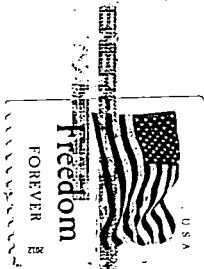
