

ORDER

Appellant appeals from an order issued by the circuit court regarding arbitration of a contract dispute. On June 20, 2025, Respondents moved to dismiss the appeal, arguing the appeal was interlocutory and not immediately appealable and seeking sanctions. Appellants filed a return, opposing the dismissal and seeking a motion to stay "Pending Discovery Concerning Respondent's Certificate of Termination." Respondents filed a reply in support of its motion to dismiss and opposing the motion to stay, and Appellants filed a reply in support of the motion to stay. After careful consideration of the filings, we deny Respondents' request for sanctions and dismiss the appeal as interlocutory and not immediately appealable.¹
