

**MOTION TO HOLD APPEAL IN ABEYANCE  
OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE,  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the Respondents Joan Macatee and Jennifer Browning, as Guardian for Joan Macatee, hereby move for an Order of this Court holding the pending appeal in abeyance. The parties have reached a settlement in concept which needs to be formalized in writing and then approval by the Greenville County Probate Court. It is likely that this process will take more than thirty (30) days.
