## ORDER



Petitioner filed a motion for a ten-day extension to serve and file a petition for a writ of certiorari following the court of appeals' decision in *Murphy v. Halocarbon Products Corp.*, Op. No. 2024-UP-349 (S.C. Ct. App. filed Oct. 9, 2024). The Court granted Petitioner's motion. Thereafter, on March 11, 2025, this Court granted Petitioner's counsel's motion to withdraw as counsel and stay the time limits for serving and filing the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix until June 9, 2025. Petitioner did not request a second extension to serve and file the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix.
