Good afternoon:

I hope this email finds you well! On August 14, 2025, our office received the attached Order granting our petition for a Writ of Certiorari by the Court. We have two questions we humbly ask for clarification, please:

1. The attached Order states the parties shall serve and file "the appendix...in the matter provided by Rule 242(i), SCACR." However, according to the April 30, 2024 Order, "Formatting and Additional Copies in Appellate Matters Under Rule 267(f), SCACR," section (c) states the requirement to file the Appendix along with the Writ of Certiorari is suspended. Thus, no Appendix was filed with our Writ of Certiorari on April 7, 2025.
 - a. **Question:** Since we did not file an Appendix with our Writ of Certiorari due to the suspension, are we ordered to draft/serve/file an Appendix with our upcoming briefs since it is mentioned in the attached Order to do so? Or is filing an Appendix still suspended?

2. The attached Order states the parties shall "file ten additional copies of the appendix and ten copies of their briefs in the matter provided by Rule 242(i), SCACR."
 - a. **Question:** Is the Court requesting "ten additional copies" of each brief (petitioner's brief/respondent's brief/petitioner's reply brief) at the time each brief is served? Or does the Court want "ten additional copies" at the end after all briefs have been served?
