## ORDER

---

Following Appellant's appeal to this court, Respondent moved to amend his complaint, which included the addition of claims that allegedly involved federal questions. When one of the parties removed the case to federal court, this court explained it would hold the appeal in abeyance until the case was remanded to state court and ordered Appellant to provide status updates every sixty days. In one status update, Appellant informed the court Respondent had filed a voluntary dismissal of the action in federal court. In response, on June 24, 2025, this court dismissed the appeal on the basis Appellant wished to withdraw the appeal.

On August 4, 2025, Appellant filed a motion to amend the dismissal order, explaining it had not moved to withdraw the appeal, and thus the order was factually incorrect, but it agreed the appeal was moot and should be dismissed. Appellant requests the order be amended to correctly reflect the events that have transpired. Respondent did not file a return. After careful consideration, we grant Appellant's motion to amend the dismissal order and clarify the appeal is dismissed because Respondent has dismissed the underlying complaint. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
