Dear Clerk of Court of S.C. Court of Appeals:

I am in receipt of your ORDER dated August 28, 2025, which I received today September 2, 2025. Thank you.

Your ORDER dismisses the above referenced matter for failure to provide the order challenged on appeal and the 250.00 filing fee.

On June 10, 2025, your office provided me with notice that you had received my appeal, assigned a case number, and if I had any questions to contact your office. In response to your June 10 paper, on June 18, 2025, I notified your office that I am an indigent prisoner trying to get my application for post-conviction relief papers docketed, that the action is a criminal matter and that I could not afford your fees, and that I do not have the final order from the State Ethics Commission yet as I am awaiting their answer to my Motion for Leave To Amend Complaint By Interlineation, which I sent to them on May 27, 2025, and, I also provided your office with a question regarding the title in the instant appeal, all of which you have not replied to.

As of today, I still have not received a reply from the State Ethics Commission, I still do not have any money to pay for your court costs, costs which I believe should not be charged being I am pursuing releif in a criminal matter, and I still have the same question as to the title of the appeal being State Ethics Commission instead of James C. Campbell

I will be providing the State Ethics Commission a third notice requesting a status update in regards to the Motion To Amend, which they have ignored my status update requests to this day so far.


Additionally, in my June 18, 2025 reply to your June 10, 2025 paper, I notified you that I filed with your office a 'percautionary appeal'. Please keep in mind I filed this 'percautionary appeal' because the parties in the action are still in settlement discussions and have not reached an agreement yet. The Ethics Commission is dragging their feet, not me, and I do not want to lose my right to appeal because the Ethics Commission wants to play possum.

I request that this court reinstate this appeal and hold it in abeyance until I straighten matters out with the S.C. State Ethics Commission in regards to the Sumter County Clerk of Court's unlawful acts of misfeasance and obstruction of justice.

S.C. State Ethics Commission and Sumter County Clerk of Court will be contemporaneously served with this document on this day.
