I'm writing to report what occurred immediately after we filed our objection in the Court of Appeals this morning.

I (Lynne Chatlos) went to the Dorchester County Clerk's Office to submit a proof of delivery so there would be a clear record. At the counter, (12:22pm) Chief Deputy Clerk of Court Priscilla L. Bolen stated she had already sent an email (11:57am) and made calls and then pressed me to sign a 'consent' so that all motions set for hearing on Monday, September 15, 2025, could go forward. I told Ms. Bolen I am not a party to that case and could not sign on behalf of Attia Elbadawy.

Despite this, she persisted. After I refused, she acknowledged that Attia's consent was 'not even needed.

Why even bother to ask for the consent in the first place?

For the Court's awareness, I am attaching Ms. Bolen's email (time stamped September 12, 2025, at 11:57 AM) requesting that we confirm consent. This incident reflects an effort to manufacture 'consent' to lower court hearings that should not proceed while this appeal remains pending, and no remittitur has been issued.
