ORDER

Appellant has filed a notice of appeal from the denial of his motion for immunity pursuant to the Protection of Persons and Property Act (the Act).¹ Respondent has filed a motion to dismiss. Because the denial of a request for immunity under the Act is not immediately appealable, Respondent's motion to dismiss is granted. *See State v. Isaac*, 405 S.C. 177, 187, 747 S.E.2d 677, 682 (2013) ("[T]he denial of a defendant's request for immunity under the Act is an interlocutory order not subject to immediate appeal . . .").

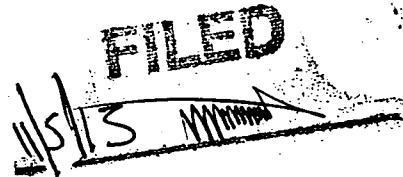
