## ORDER

---

On May 12, 2025, the circuit court dismissed Appellant's appeal from the magistrate court on the basis Appellant failed to comply with the bond prescribed by the magistrate court. Appellant then appealed the circuit court's dismissal order to this court and moved to stay the circuit court's May 12, 2025 order. On July 15, 2025, this court temporarily granted Appellant's motion to stay the eviction and remanded the case to the circuit court for the limited purpose of holding a hearing on Appellant's motion to stay and for determination of any appeal bond. On August 1, 2025, the circuit court set the bond to stay enforcement of its May 12, 2025 order, which required Appellant to pay \$15,800 by August 15, 2025 and \$2,450 every month thereafter on the first day of the month.

On August 20, 2025, Respondent informed this court the circuit court had issued an order dismissing the circuit court matter for failure to prosecute on August 18, 2025, and that Appellant failed to comply with the circuit court's August 1, 2025 appeal bond. However, on September 5, 2025, the circuit court withdrew its order dismissing for failure to prosecute on the basis it was unnecessary. We now remand to the circuit court for the limited purpose of considering whether to lift the stay of its May 12, 2025 for non-compliance.
