* Would you please send me a bill and a stamped copy of my original complaint (not the Appeals necessarily, but these would be great too) If you need payment first that's fine too - and expected.



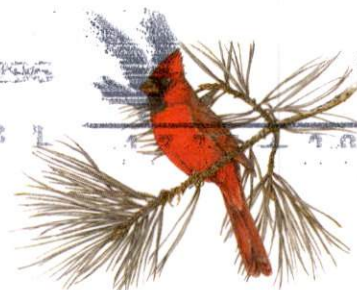
