threats to my personal safety, I respectfully request that this Court issue a Protective Order to ensure my life safety

and legal rights.

Reasons:

1. On multiple occasions, when I attempted to deliver court-stamped documents, I was obstructed, and even

experienced repeated errors or irregularities at different post offices, which seriously interfered with the proper

progress of my case.

2. The defendant, Tony Lin, twice refused to accept official court documents and even threatened to call police, showing contempt for the authority of the Court.

3. I suspect I am under constant surveillance and being followed. I do not dare to carry my phone when leaving

home, and I live in constant fear even when going to the supermarket, writing, or mailing letters. My heart

condition has worsened and I fear my life is in danger at any time.

4. I am deeply concerned that future case deliveries, hearings, and even my daily outings will continue to be

threatened. Therefore, I urgently request this Court to issue a Protective Order and instruct law enforcement to

ensure my basic personal safety and normal litigation rights.

I respectfully ask the Court of Appeals to review and approve this application for a Protective Order without delay,

and to urge the relevant judicial and law enforcement authorities to assist in its enforcement, preventing further threats, obstruction, and retaliation by the defendant or related individuals.
