I am in receipt of your letter dated September 5, 2025, in which I received on September 10, 2025. As such, In your letter you stated that you have not received any information indicating that the court reporter ~~has~~ been granted an extension, and that you have not received not received the transcript nor my initial brief.

Please be advise that I have tried on several occassions to obtain the correct name of the court reporter from the office of court administration and from Judge Coble, but as of this date I have not recived anytresponse. On April 9, 2025, upon receiving a letter from you dated April 3, 2025, in which you stated that you have received my initial brief, designation of natter, and appendix; and to provide proof of ordering the transcript within 10 days. I requestd for the transcript from the info given, Legal Eagle, Erin Reilly the court reporter, but as you can see the correspondence was received by the institution mailroom on April 14, 2025, but return to sender and received by the institution mailroom July 16, 2025, three months after my initial request. 

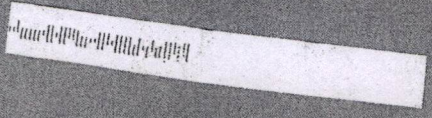

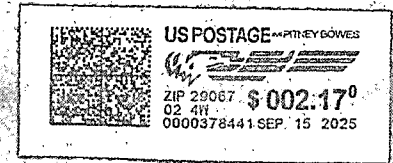
