MOTION FOR SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE RECORD ON APPEAL

Pursuant to Rules 210(a), 240, and 263 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellant CarMax Auto Superstores, Inc. (“CarMax”) requests an extension of time to file the Record on Appeal in the above-captioned matter until such time as the Court has considered and ruled upon the recently filed Uncontested Motion to File Portions of the Record on Appeal under Seal (the “Uncontested Motion to File under Seal”). This is the second request for an extension of this deadline.
