Request to have pleading for Declaratory Judgment dated 1-7-2025 addressed and issued in order to declare rights and other legal relations

PCR court (Berkeley County) is violating Appellate processes ~~and~~^{E.R.} and Mr. Roberts due process of law to seek Appellate review by deliberately defaulting on Mr. Roberts claims by not making an appearance in the action without good cause to which PCR court is in "default" as has been since June 14, 2025.
