This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the brief of appellant pursuant to White v. State in the case of Samuel Smiley v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 17, 2025. Counsel filed the petition


for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Samuel Smiley v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 17, 2025. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Joey Corvell Reid before the Supreme Court on September 9, 2025. Counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in the case of The State v. Cleveland Maxwell with the Court of Appeals on August 25, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Travis Alston with the Court of Appeals on August 15, 2025. Counsel filed the brief of appellant pursuant to White v. State in the case of Jonathan Nieves v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 13, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jonathan Nieves v. The State with the Supreme Court on August 18, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Mustafa Salaam with the Court of Appeals on August 8, 2025. Counsel filed the initial brief of respondent in the case of The State v. Gene Alexzander Scott with the Court of Appeals on July 30, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Zachir Devaunte Shyiim McCall with the Supreme Court on July 23, 2025. Counsel filed the brief of appellant pursuant to White v. State in the case of Shelly Faulling v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 9, 2025. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Shelly Faulling v. The State with the Supreme Court on July 9, 2025.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that his caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

4. On August 29, 2025 opposing counsel, the Attorney General’s Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a thirty-day extension from September 19, 2025 until October 20, 2025. Counsel respectfully requests that the time limits for filing the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.


