MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Lorenzo Bernard Young respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, from September 19, 2025 until October 20, 2025** in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Lorenzo Bernard Young respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the


number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. On September 5, 2025, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in In Re The Care and Treatment of George Pierson with the Court of Appeals. On August 29, 2025, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Kahmil Cooper with the Court of Appeals. On August 28, 2025, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. James Boatwright with the Court of Appeals. On August 15, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Benjamin Doyle v. The State with the Supreme Court. On August 12, 2025, counsel filed the brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Michael Jeter with the Court of Appeals. On August 1, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Artrell Hickson v. The State with the Supreme Court. On July 28, 2025, counsel filed the initial reply brief of appellant in The State v. Lorenzo Boles with the Court of Appeals. On July 23, 2025, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Alexander Reid v. The State with the Supreme Court. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


4. On August 27, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension from September 19, 2025 until October 20, 2025** in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. Counsel requests that time limits for filing the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
