Ms. Bolen and Ms. Lemacks,

I hope this email finds you well. I am contacting you regarding the above-referenced case, which currently has a Motion schedule for October 6, 2025, in front of Judge Goodstein.

As background, on July 18, 2025, the Plaintiffs filed (in the Court of Appeals) a motion to stay the circuit court's May 6, 2025, and June 23, 2025 orders, which respectively denied the Plaintiffs' motion for a temporary injunction and/or preliminary injunction. On July 30, 2025, the Court of Appeals construed Plaintiffs' motion as a petition for a writ of supersedeas pursuant to Rule 241 of the SCACR requesting a temporary injunction. On August 13, 2025, the Court of Appeals remanded the case back to circuit court to allow the circuit court to expeditiously review the petition for a writ of supersedes, return, and reply, and determine whether the exhibits provided in those filings were part of the record before the court at its January 21, 2025 hearing.

As the Honorable Maite Murphy was the judge that presided over those hearings and signed the May 6, 2025 and June 23, 2025 orders (the orders being appealed by Plaintiffs), it is D.R. Horton's position that Judge Murphy, specifically, needs to hear this motion. I have attached the August 13, 2025 Court of Appeals Order for your review and reference. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.
