

ORDER

This appeal arises out of Appellant's convictions and sentences for assault and battery in the second degree and resisting law enforcement. Appellant moves to relieve his appointed attorney. After careful consideration, Appellant's motion to relieve counsel is denied. *State v. Roberts*, 364 S.C. 583, 588, 614 S.E.2d 626, 629 (2005) (stating there is no constitutional right to proceed pro se).

Counsel filed a brief and motion to be relieved pursuant to the procedure set forth by *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396 (1967). The Court will consider counsel's motion to be relieved upon review of the Anders brief and record on appeal.
