MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO
SERVE AND FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Kenneth Dawson respectfully requests a fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from September 22, 2025 until October 22, 2025, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Kenneth Dawson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Shamar Latrell Stanley with the Court of Appeals on September 19, 2025. Counsel filed a Return to Motion to Appoint Outside Counsel in Gary Dubose Terry v. The State, a capital PCR, with the Supreme Court on September 11, 2025. Counsel spoke at the Summary Court Intensive Training on September 9, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Jason Ervin Black v. The State with the Court of Appeals on August 11, 2025. Counsel was a presenter at a CLE in Columbia on August 9, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Bobbie Jo Baynard with the Court of Appeals on July 30, 2025. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Wiley Chapman with the Supreme Court on July 17, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Marques Quantez Heath with the Court of Appeals on July 7, 2025. Counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Arkevus Jimon Cauthen before the Court of Appeals on June 11, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Dominick Thompson v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 30, 2025. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Courtney Cordae Richards with the Court of Appeals on May 12, 2025. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying Appendix in the case of Charles Winston v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 12, 2025.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload


will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested. On August 27, 2025, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through September 30, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a fourth and final thirty (30) day extension from September 22, 2025 until October 22, 2025, in which to serve and file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances.


