NOTICE OF OBJECTION

I, Sherman Smith, the natural living being and **Noncitizen State National**, reserve my right not to be compelled to perform under contract or commercial agreement that I did not enter into **knowingly, willingly, voluntarily or intentionally**, and I, furthermore do not accept any liability of the compelled benefit of any unrevealed contract or commercial agreement. – UCC 1-207/UCC 1-308.

I am here on **“special appearance”** to defend **the inappropriately, erroneously, & fraudulently charged “Estate” referenced, under duress of unlawful seizure, extortion, defamation of character, discrimination, Fraud & unlawful void orders due to lack of jurisdiction.**

1. Appellant Sherman Smith objects to the order filed on September 2, 2025 denying a petition for rehearing based on the grounds that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded.
2. Appellant’s status as a noncitizen state national principle of law has been overlooked and disregarded.
3. The challenge of subject matter jurisdiction has been overlooked and disregarded.
4. The challenge of personal jurisdiction has been overlooked and disregarded.

5. The fact that the lower courts' Master in Equity Stephanie N. Lawrence electronically signed a Writ of Assistance to have Appellant and family forcibly removed from their private property on September 1, 2025 while jurisdiction is exclusively held by the Appeals Court, showing a predetermined rush to judgement while ignoring all the material facts and evidence presented on the record (which is a malicious violation of due process, a malicious violation of the 4th and 5th Amendment, evidence of collusion and a biased position on the matter), has been overlooked and disregarded.
6. The subject of lawful standing has been overlooked and disregarded.
7. The subject of silent acquiescence, tacit agreement, and 13 unrebutted averments has been overlooked and disregarded.
8. The material fact that the Appellant's private property is held in an irrevocable expressed, non-statutory, complex, discretionary, private living trust has been overlooked and disregarded.
9. The fact that FREEDOM MORTGAGE CORPORATION is not a living being/man and has not presented any evidence on the record of a lawful binding contract that was not created out of fraud or deception and that consists of the 4 essentials that make a contract lawful and binding (*A. Full disclosure, B. Equal consideration, C. Lawful Terms and Conditions, and D. The wet ink signature of both parties (corporations can not sign because they have no right or mind to contract since they are soulless legal fictions; and no third party can sign a contract on their behalf)*) has been overlooked and disregarded.
10. The fact that there is no injured party has been overlooked and disregarded.
11. The fact that there is no sworn statement from an injured party has been overlooked and disregarded.
12. The violation of 42 U.S.C. § 1983 – Deprivation of rights under color of law has been overlooked and disregarded.
13. The violation of 42 U.S.C. § 1985 – Conspiracy to interfere with civil rights has been overlooked and disregarded.
14. The violation of 42 U.S.C. § 1986 – Neglect to prevent known violations has been overlooked and disregarded.
15. The fact that these 14 material facts and principles of law were never addressed is a serious, direct, and malicious violation of due process and a violation of the Appellant's 4th and 5th amendments, which raises cause of action for remedy and relief.

Remedy and Relief Sought

1. The reinstatement of Appeals Case number 2025-001099, for case #2023-CP-400-3343 to be overturned and dismissed with prejudice, or for a remittitur to instruct the Master in Equity of the lower courts to dismiss with prejudice.

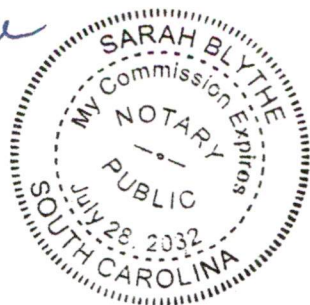


