**APPELLANT’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF AND  
DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN THE RECORD**

Appellant Adams Outdoor Advertising Limited Partnership (“Appellant” or “Adams”), by and through its undersigned counsel, and with the consent of Respondent West & Joyce, LLC, successor in interest to West Oil Company (“Respondent”), respectfully moves this Court, pursuant to Rules 240 and 263, SCACR, for entry of an Order extending the time within which Appellant must file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal (“Designation of Matter”) by thirty (30) days, such that the deadline would be extended to November 10, 2025. The grounds for this motion are as follows:

1. Appellant received the requested transcripts of the lower court proceedings in this matter on September 10, 2025. As such, pursuant to Rules 208(a) and 209(a), SCACR, the current deadline for Appellant to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter is October 10, 2025.

2. Appellant seeks a 30-day extension of said deadline to allow undersigned counsel sufficient time to review the record of the lower court proceedings and prepare the Initial Brief, given existing personal and professional commitments in other matters.

3. Both of Appellant's attorneys have multiple professional commitments in the weeks leading up to the current deadline, including substantive filing deadlines and court proceedings in other cases. Additionally, undersigned counsel previously obtained Secure Leave through the Judicial Branch's Attorney Information System for the time period of October 6, 2025 through October 17, 2025 for a planned vacation out of state. A copy of the secure leave designation confirmation from AIS is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

4. This is Appellant's first request for an extension of time within to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. This request is supported by good cause and is not made in an effort to unnecessarily delay these proceedings.

5. Accordingly, Appellant respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order extending the deadline to file its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter by thirty (30) days, such that the proposed date of the new deadline is November 10, 2025.<sup>1</sup> Granting this motion would promote the interests of justice and preserve Court resources.

<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to Rule 263(a), SCACR, because the thirtieth day after the current deadlines falls on a Sunday (November 9, 2025), the requested extended deadline, if granted, runs until the end of the next business day, which is Monday, November 10, 2025.
