

## ORDER

---

Appellant filed his final reply brief on June 11, 2025. On September 2, 2025, Appellant filed a "motion reply brief in response to Respondent's final brief," which appears to be a second final reply brief. On September 4, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to strike Appellant's "motion reply brief in response to Respondent's final brief," arguing it was an improper filing under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. On September 5, 2025, Appellant filed a "response in opposition to Respondent's motion to strike," arguing Respondent's final brief emphasized matters not emphasized in its initial brief. In the alternative, Appellant requested this court exercise its discretion and accept his filing as a supplemental brief. On September 10, 2025, Respondent filed a "reply in support of [its] motion to strike Appellant's motion reply brief." On September 11, 2025, Appellant filed "sur-reply in opposition to Respondent's motion to strike."

We construe Appellant's September 2, 2025 filing as a motion to file an amended final reply brief. After careful consideration, we deny Appellant's request to file an amended final reply brief. We also deny Appellant's request to allow supplemental briefing. Based on our denial of Appellant's motion to file an amended final brief, Respondent's motion to strike is moot.
