Mannetta v. Sinclair, Appellate Case No. 2025-001313

Dear Clerk:

I write to provide an update regarding the status of my transcript request in the above-referenced appeal.

On August 22, 2025, this Court issued an order granting me permission to file my transcript request outside the Rule 207 SCACR deadline. I promptly submitted my request (ID #766232227) through the official

portal. Despite multiple follow-ups, I received no communication until today, September 25, 2025, when Legal Eagle, the designated transcript vendor, finally acknowledged receipt of the assignment.

In their correspondence, Legal Eagle admitted that my request was overlooked. They have now agreed to move the transcript into expedited production without requiring a deposit, while charging the standard service rate. I am awaiting confirmation of an estimated completion date and invoice.

I submit this update so the Court is aware that the delay has not been caused by me, but rather by the transcript office's failure to process the request in a timely manner. I remain ready to pay the invoice immediately upon receipt and will continue to prosecute this appeal diligently.

Please advise if the Court requires any additional filings to preserve my rights while I await the transcript's completion.
