

To Whom It May Concern:

Regarding Civil Action Number 2011-CP-46-04281:

I have received your summons with regard to the above action and there are several points on which there seems to be some confusion. As I told you in my original response to your request for a deposition in this matter, I have no direct knowledge of this matter, except through conversations with Ms. Sheila Riley-Stamp, who discussed the matter with me in confidence, and with the understanding that our discussions would remain private.

You seem to be under the impression that I have some business interest in Sheila's Electrolysis, and that is incorrect. I am not now, nor have I at any time been an owner, operator, principal, or partner in Sheila's Electrolysis. I have not operated in any decision-making capacity for Sheila's Electrolysis and have never been an employee of Sheila's Electrolysis or received any share of profits from the business.

The device which you mention in your summons is the Cutera Solera Prowave 770. This device is an IPL device, NOT A LASER, and its use is not addressed by any regulations that apply to the ownership or operation of lasers. It uses Intense Pulsed Light to facilitate hair removal, the same technology used in the "No No ®" device approved for over the counter sale to consumers. It is a more sophisticated and safer version of the IPL hair removal devices used in many spas and salons.

I believe that your attempt to draw me into this action is illegitimate, and based on misconceptions that I believe you could have and should have explored more carefully before taking this step. It is easy enough to confirm the nature of the device your claim addresses, and as simple to confirm through financial records, business licenses, etc that I have no business interest in Sheila's Electrolysis. If I am not immediately withdrawn from this suit, it is my intention to pursue a counter action against both your firm and your client in this matter for filing a false claim against me which has the potential to do me professional harm and to seek compensation for the time required from my practice to respond.

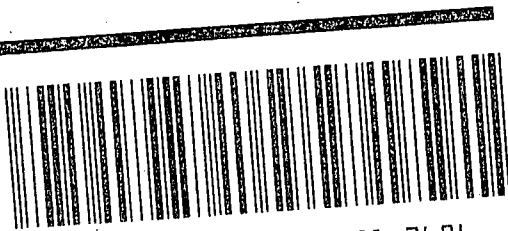

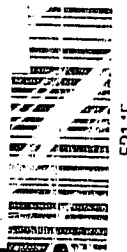
